

Group hunt

(Differentiated)

The aim of this task is for pupils to match parts of a picture. This will encourage pupils to look and discuss the contents of a picture in order to find the match.

You will need to have a selection of pictures cut into 2 or 3 parts. Mix the parts up and give a piece to each pupil.

They then need to hunt the other part(s) by comparing it with other pupils.

To follow up the activity pupils will then need to write down what the picture show. To support this section of the activity you may wish to give pupils a series of questions to answer to guide their thinking.

To differentiate using **GAP**:

As with the undifferentiated version of this task you will need several pictures cut into pieces. For each set of pictures you could have a version with some parts of it blanked out to make the task more challenging. The challenge will come from the students having to discuss and decide it fits the potentially matching piece.

Green	To support you, you will be given a 'Green' piece of a picture.
Amber	To challenge yourself you will be given an 'Amber' piece of a picture.
Pink	To extend yourself you will be given a 'Pink' piece of a picture.
