

Green Pen- Circles

The aim of Green Pen Circles is to encourage students to explore their reflective points. Through this process they will develop a deep understanding of what is good about their work and why, and more importantly what needs to be improved and why.

Students are required to present their answers, written within circles. The reason for this is it gives a visual approach to the task, which makes it more engaging and as a result encourages the students to concentrate deeper. Secondly the size of the circle is a good indication as to the length of the comment (hence the depth) required.

Give each of your students a copy of the circles worksheet. They should choose which level of challenge they would like to try-

Green- they need to give a strength or an area for development.

Amber- they need to give a strength or an area for development along with a reason.

Pink- they need to give a strength or an area for development along with 2 reasons.
