

# Lesson Basics- Presentation

**Engage the whole class in student presentation activities to ensure that learning is continuous for all**

Asking students to plan and present their ideas or findings is a great way to develop learning, check understanding and involve individual, paired, group or whole class work. With this type of activity, it is important to remember that the learning continues into the presentations and as such a structure is needed to maintain this. With presentations always set a time limit so that pace is maintained to the lesson. For those students who are observing the presentations ensure that you use simple active listening techniques such as answering questions, checking for keywords or points, completing a peer assessment or having to create questions to quiz the presenters with afterwards.

- Listen carefully to the presentations
- Complete the activity you have been assigned
- Be prepared to feedback following the presentations

Teacher spotlight...

- Set a time limit for each presentation
- Use active listening strategies to engage all students
- Provide opportunity for peer assessment or Q&A
