

Lesson Basics- Video Clip

Ensure that students fully engage with video clips through active listening and observation skills

Opportunities for using video, often via YouTube is a great way to communicate information to students. However, what should not be overlooked is the need for good listening and observational skills, all learners need to be able to interact with what is being shown. When asking students to watch a video try to include active listening strategies. This is achieved simply through taking notes of the key points, setting questions to be answered and students raising questions related to the video. Also, consider watching video at least twice to allow students to fully digest what is being shown.

Spotlight/Focus...

- Listen carefully
- Make short notes of the keywords/points
- Note any question you may have

Teacher spotlight...

- Use active listening strategies to engage students fully
- Outline expectations prior to watching the video
- Time permitting, try showing the video twice to develop understanding of what has been shown
